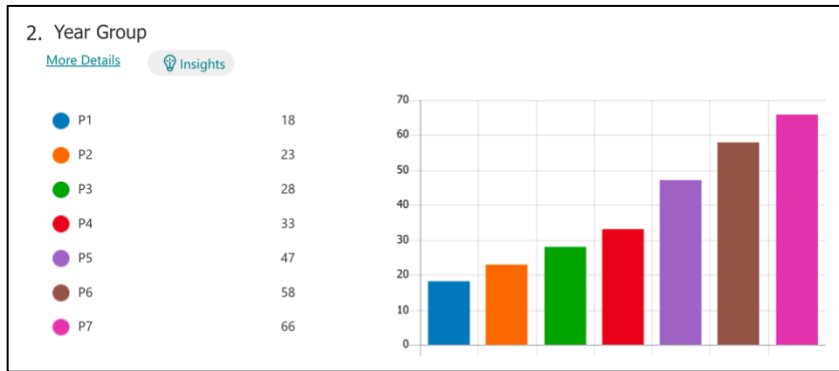


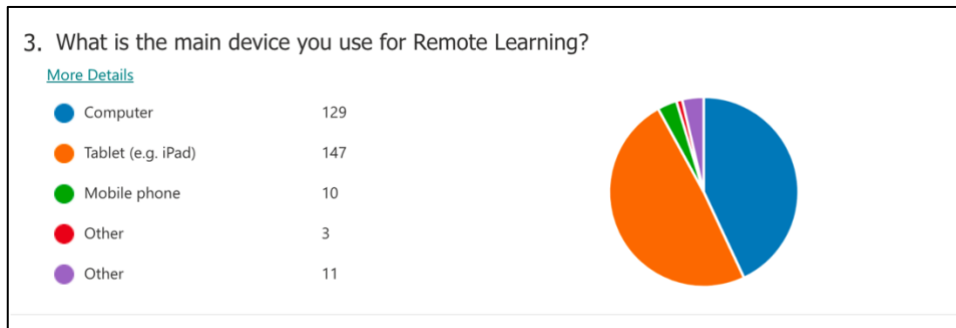
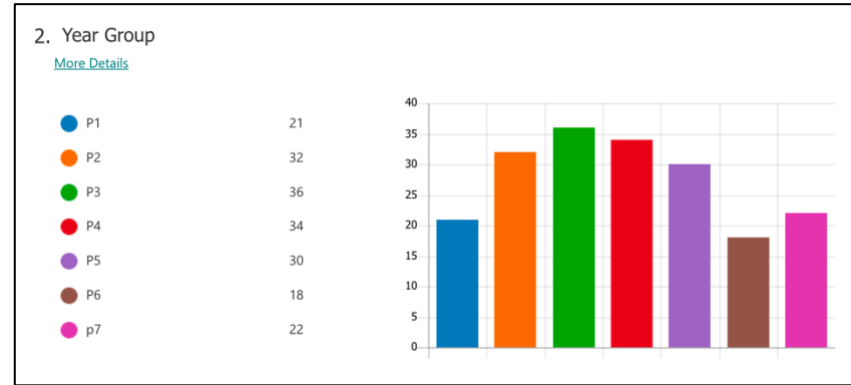
PUPIL SURVEY BY STAGE

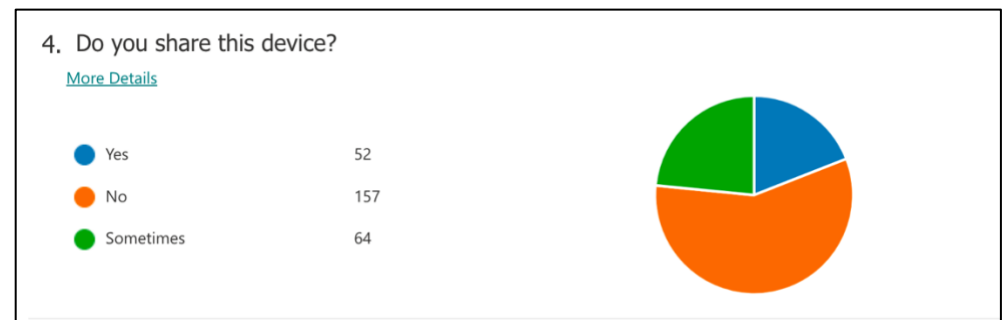

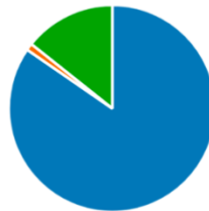


PUPIL SURVEY – FEEDBACK FROM TEACHER

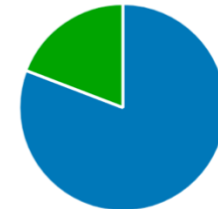

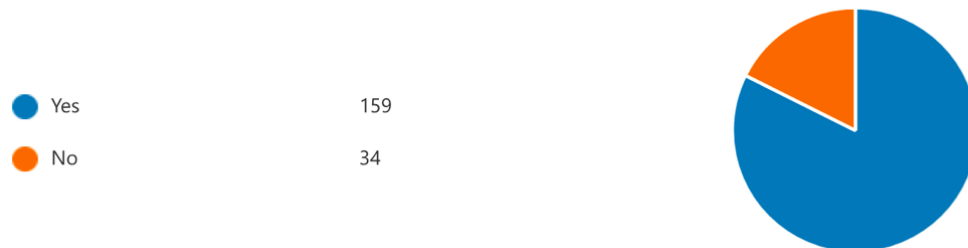
