Our next phase of Home Learning seeks to build consistent approaches across the school which will allow pupils to begin to share their learning with us and receive feedback. One of the positives of the current situation is the opportunity to expand our use of technology but we want this to be manageable for everyone so we will build up this capacity slowly and steadily over the first weeks of the summer term. Weekly Home Learning Grids will continue to be used as we support the transition to ways of working which will be new for children, families and staff. 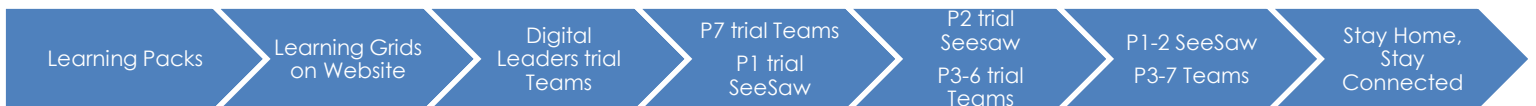
We wish to move towards providing opportunities to check in with pupils directly via online platforms and to provide online daily feedback and support at designated times. P1 and P7 pupils have begun to pilot this new way of home learning, with P2-P6 coming on board next week. Class Teachers will email families with log on details and we will guide and support you and your children in how to access either **SeeSaw (P1-P2)** or **Teams (P3-P7)**. Although we are not permitted to use Zoom or similar, Office 365 does have video capabilities, with certain restrictions on their use to ensure safeguarding for pupils and staff. We will adhere to Council guidance but this is an evolving situation so we will update and advise you on methods we can use to connect safely with the children as we begin to roll out our new online platforms.
